Q & A

How is this Fund different from other equity income funds?

It invests only in leading UK Blue chip equities not the entire UK Equity market. There is no small company risk and it is not run like a traditional income fund; the Fund targets growth stocks within the UK leading Index. It has a thematic selection process as such it offers welcome diversification in the equity income space where a lot of funds all select the same stocks.

Why are growth stocks more attractive?

These companies have a strong base of recurring revenues as well as significant market share. Growing need for commodities from all corners of the globe solidify demand for raw materials produced, these companies are one of the most highly profitable sectors in the market place and the major companies are comfortable paying very high dividend yields to investors.

Why invest in the leading UK stocks?

Investing only in the leading blue chip equities means no small company or illiquidity or currency risk within the portfolio.

What type of investors would this appeal to?

A broad range of investors would find this strategy useful – primarily those looking for income but not at the expense of capital growth. The underlying stock selection is based purely on the fundamentals of each company and each sector. High conviction thematic sector selection.

What are the risks?

Investment aims and Structure

This is a UK UCITS Fund which invests in a selection of leading UK blue chip equities through a combination of active stock selection and a competitive yield with no illiquidity or currency risk

Investment strategy

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Aims to boost the income from a portfolio of leading UK Blue Chip Equities enabling investors to benefit from higher income while not necessarily missing out on capital gains



Targets cyclical growth stocks rather than traditional income stocks, which can underperform in a bull market. High conviction thematic stock selection.


Investment process



The holdings in the portfolio are selected by a combination of top-down thematic strategy and bottom-up stock selection. Technical analysis is used extensively to help time investment decisions



Stock selection is not necessarily limited to high yielding stocks and although the portfolio has a high target yield overall – there is still a place in the fund for one or two lower yielders






